





The First Aid at Work course qualification is typically achieved through a 3-day class-room based training course. Our requirement for this is refreshment days. The First Aid at Work course qualification assesses the candidate's knowledge and skills in a practical environment. The course training also includes questions. What next?

Certificates for successful learners will be dispatched for distribution in due course (approx 2 weeks). This qualification lasts for a period of 3 years after which point learners will need to retest the course. *Please note that in line with the Guidelines of the Resuscitation Council all our First Aid courses will cover Debridement training as part of the subjects.
