Very functional as a meditation space, office or bedroom. Approximate dimensions, downstairs, 8ft x 6 ft Upstairs, 13 foot long, x 7 ft wide and 6 ft 5" high Total height, NOTE! - 17FT The roof is made from aluminium, with solid brass strips between running down it and lined and insulated. The ends of the roof are tipped in copper. Inside, up, there are 4 ventilation points I will arrange delivery and installation, included in the price. As this beautiful place is too high to go on normal heavy load trucks (being 5.2 metres), the temple/house or shrine if you like, will be delivered in two parts, top and bottom, then re-membered, anywhere in England or Wales.
